Ernest F. Ramsey, 91, formerly of Stafford Springs, CT, husband of the late Elizabeth V. "Ginger" Ramsey, passed away on Wednesday, December 5, 2012 at the Masonic Home, Wallingford, CT. He was born in Stafford Springs, CT, son of the late Archibald and Aurelia (Tellier) Ramsey. Ernie was a U.S. Marine Corps veteran of World War II, and had retired from the Town of Stafford as a maintenance worker. He was a member of St. Edward Parish, and Strazza, Tonoli-Emhoff Post No. 26 American Legion. To many he was known as the "Monkey Man", Stafford's own tree surgeon. Ernie is survived by his two children, Dale E. Ramsey of Monson, MA, and Darlene R. Davis and her husband Gary of Simsbury, CT; two grandchildren, Stephen and Catherine Davis; two sisters, Laura Czapla and her husband John, and Elaine Malloy and her husband Bob; and several nieces and nephews.
