Isabell was a member of St. Edward Parish, curator for the Stafford Historical Society, member of the Stafford Democratic town committee, the Stafford Senior Center, the Staffordville Fire Department Ladies Auxiliary, and the Ladies Auxiliary of the Italian Benefit Society. She also worked at the Stafford Thrift Shop for many years, enjoyed gardening and antiquing, and was an advocate for many Stafford town projects.
