Leroy Tiziani, born May 21, 1929, of Orcuttville Road, Stafford Springs, CT, passed away on Saturday, May 3, 2008 after a short battle with illness. Leroy leaves his loving wife of 51 years, Patricia A. Tiziani, two sons of whom he was so proud, Lee Tiziani of Hartford, CT and Glen Tiziani and his wife Carol of Colchester, CT, and the pride and joy of his life, his two grandsons, Matthew and Nicholas Tiziani. Leroy was also survived by a sister, Dolores T. Campo of Enfield, CT, two nephews David and Ray Campo, an uncle Harry Fontanella of Stafford Springs and a few cousins. Leroy spent his entire life in Stafford, born of Italian immigrant parents Michel and Angeline (Fontanella) Tiziani. Leroy held various positions throughout his working career, most notably a 20 year tenure as a custodian with the Stafford School system which he retired from in 1991.
