Frank G. Triska, Sr., 78, of Old Monson Rd., Stafford Springs, CT, went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, May 14, 2008 at Evergreen Health Care Center, Stafford Springs, CT. He was born in Stafford Springs, CT, son of the late Frank C. and Anne (Tomaskovic) Triska. Frank was a U.S. Army veteran of the Korean Conflict, and graduated from the Signal School. He retired as a construction engineer from the State of Connecticut Department of Transportation after 35 years of service. He was a member of St. Edward Parish and the Reverend Felix J. O'Neil Council #1395 Knights of Columbus, where he was a Fourth Degree Knight and past Grand Knight.
