Lewis C. Fletcher, 79, of Stafford Springs, CT, passed away on Thursday, October 3, 2013. He was born in Fitchburg, MA, son of the late Lewis E. C. Fletcher and Arlene (LaPrade) Fletcher. Lewis was a U.S. Air Force veteran having served during the Korean Conflict, and retired from Pratt and Whitney Aircraft as an assembler.
