Warren L. Barsaleau, Sr., 79, of Willington, CT, husband of the late Patricia (Partyka) Barsaleau, passed away on Tuesday, September 10, 2013 at Hartford Hospital. He was born in Hartford, son of the late Henry and Grace (Pinder) Barsaleau. Warren served as a Sergeant in the U.S. Marine Corps during the Korean Conflict, and retired from the Connecticut State Police after 31 years, working first as a mechanic and then in radio communications. He was a member of Grace Episcopal Church, where he was a vestryman and church historian, and the Willington Fire Dept. No. 1 where he was a former Assistant Chief. Warren was also a former constable and dog warden for the Town of Willington, as well as chairman for the Willington Recreation Committee. He enjoyed camping and going to the ocean with his family. Warren is survived by his four sons, Warren L.
