Frances Hubert, 97, of Stafford Springs, CT, wife of the late Walter Hubert, passed away on October 7, 2018. She was born in East Windsor, CT, on March 9, 1921, daughter of the late Martin and Rose (Sampeck) Zinker. Fran was a very loving woman, you never left without a kiss and hug, which led her to be known by relatives as the kissing lady. She had a love, pride in numbers whether it be the age she attained, number of children/grandchildren/great grandchildren or her chosen career path. She had worked in various positions for the Town of Stafford from 1960 to 1987. She retired as full-time Tax Collector in 1986, and again from the Borough of Stafford Springs in 1987. She was a Connecticut Certified Municipal Collector and was elected seven times as Tax Collector. She then served for one additional year in 1993 when help was needed. Fran served the Town of Stafford in many capacities beginning as an Assistant Tax Collector, Assistant to the Board of Assessors, served on the Board of Tax Review, twice served on the Revaluation team, as well as payroll clerk for the Board of Education. Fran was a member of St. Edward Parish and the Stafford Senior Center. She is survived by her four children, F. 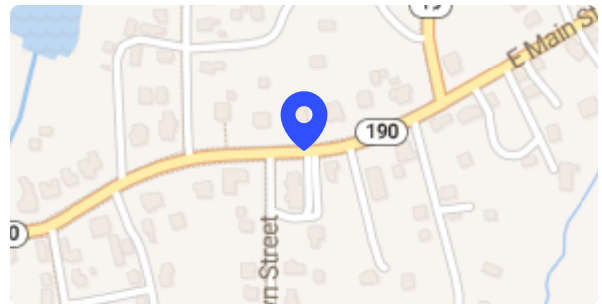

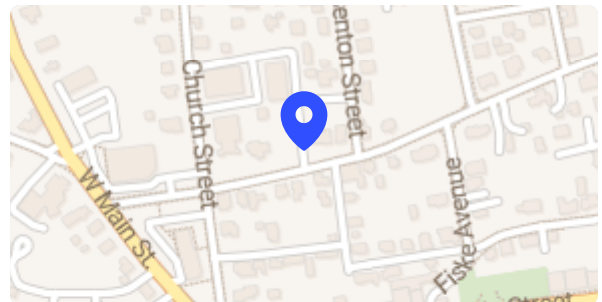

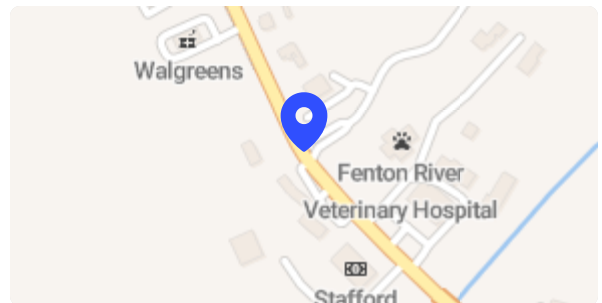
