# **Anthony R. Gregorio**

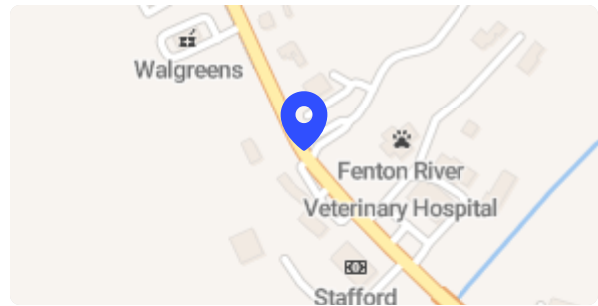
