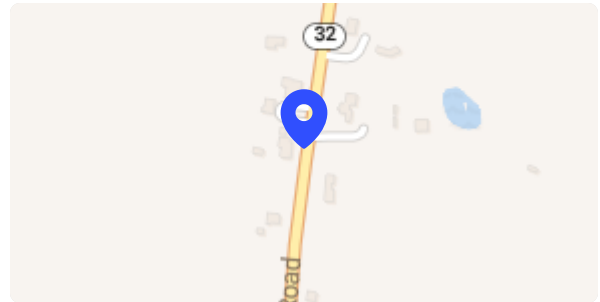
AUG 17, 2020

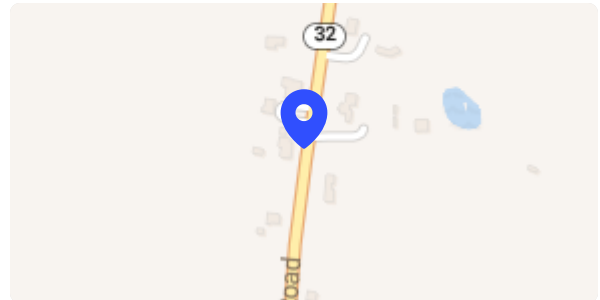
