## **Max D. Remington Jr.**

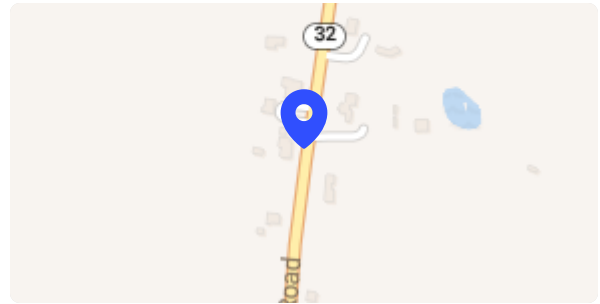
