## **Glennis A. Carroll**

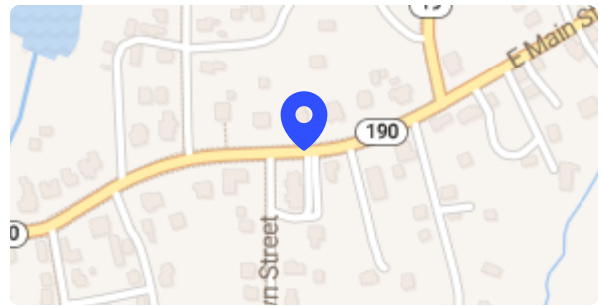

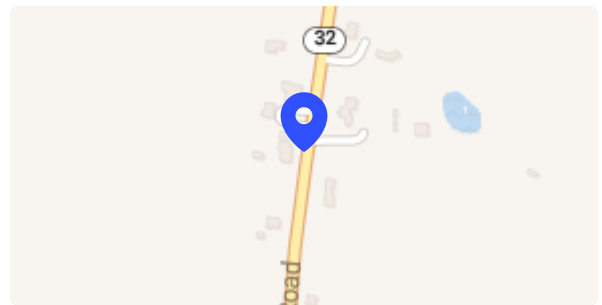
