Lucille grew up in Willington, CT, and after marriage, became a long-time resident of Stafford Springs, CT. She worked many years in the office of Home Pride Provisions (best hotdogs ever made!), and often entertained family and friends with stories of coworkers, cattle farmers and all those she interacted with. 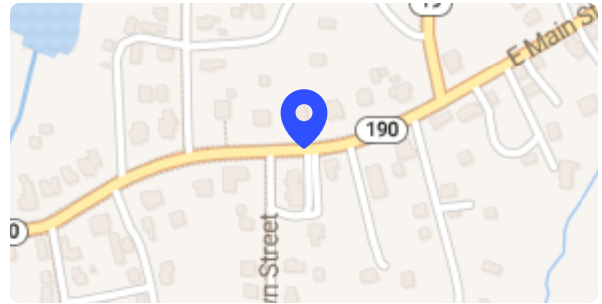

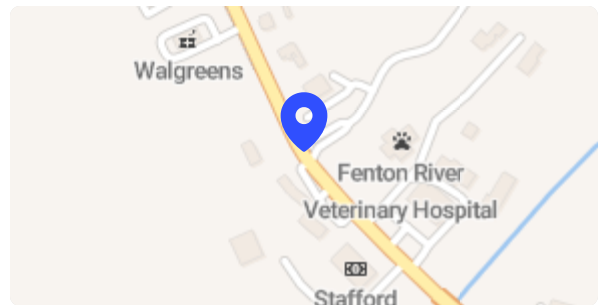
