In lieu of flowers, donations in Elizabeth's memory can be made to St. Edward Church, 27 Church St., Stafford Springs, CT 06076.

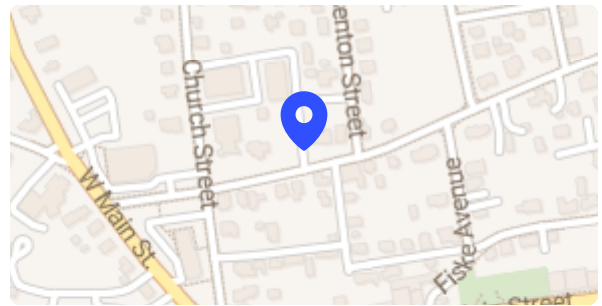

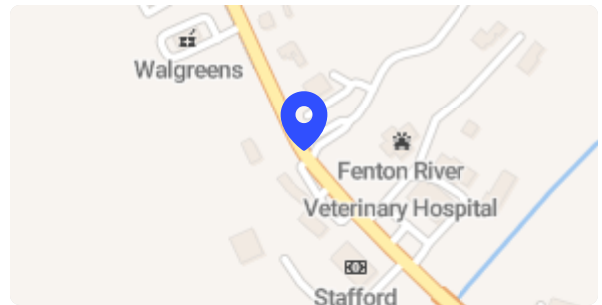
