Rose Mary Kubacka, 99, of Stafford Springs, CT, wife of the late Stephen J. Kubacka, entered into eternal life on Wednesday, April 14, 2021 at Evergreen Health Care Center. Rose survived the 1944 Hartford Circus Fire along with her sisters Helen and Anna, with Anna's husband Edward Kubacka, and his sister, Margaret. She also survived the COVID-19 virus in 2020 at the age of 98. She was a lifelong parishioner of St. Edward Church. Rose was employed at the Stafford Worsted Company as a spinner for 35 years as well as 5 years at Johnson Memorial Hospital. She also was a volunteer at St. Edward Church and School, and West Stafford School.
